



Remembrance Day Parade - Sunday, 14 November 2021

This year's Remembrance Day Services and Parade will take place on Sunday, 14 November 2021. There will be a service in St Leonard's Church at 10:00 am, followed by a parade to the Garden of Memory where there will be a short service and two minutes silence will be observed.

The Parade will proceed along Elmdon Road, between 10:40 am and 11:30 am and in order to facilitate the parade safely, there is a requirement for road closures. The following is a program of road closures, but please note that times may vary slightly.

10:57 am	Station Road, Coleshill Road Bickenhill Road	Closed until 11:04 am
11:15 am	Elmdon Road & Land Lane (bridge side & library side)	Closed until 11:30 am
11:15 am	Elmdon Road & St Leonards Close	Closed until 11:30 am
