**Re: M42 northbound junction 7 to junction 9 resurfacing letter to stakeholders**

I'm writing to inform you of some upcoming maintenance work along the M42. This work will be carried out on our behalf by our contractor, Kier.

**What we're doing and why? What are the benefits?**

We'll be carrying out resurfacing work at various locations on the M42 northbound between junction 7 and junction 9, including A4097 Kingsbury Road roundabout. The work has been identified following the deterioration of the carriageway. We'll also be replacing the road markings and road studs. The completed work will provide a smoother surface and safer road, including clearer road markings.

**When will this work take place?**

We'll start this work on **Monday 23 May 2022 and expect it to be completed by the start of July 2022**. Our work will take place overnight, when traffic is lower, from **9pm to 6am, Monday to Saturday**.

To carry out our work safely and to reduce the impact on road users and the local economy, we'll work within phased closures of the M42 as follows:

**Phase 1: 23 May 2022 to 28 May 2022** – Full closure of M42 northbound from junction 9 exit slip to junction 9 entry slip. Lane closures on M6 Toll and M42 southbound.

**Phase 2: 30 May 2022 to 10 June 2022** – Full closure of M42 junction 9 northbound exit slip. Lane closures on M6 Toll and M42 southbound. **Please note, work will be suspended over Queen's Jubilee bank holiday.**

**Phase 3: 30 May 2022 to 31 May 2022** – Full closure of M42 northbound from junction 7 to junction 9, including M6 Toll from M6 junction 3a.

**Phase 4: 11 June 2022 to 1 July 2022)** – Full closure of the M42 northbound from junction 7 to junction 8, including M6 Toll from M6 junction 3a. Northbound lane one closure on the M6 Toll

**Phase 5: 2 July 2022 to 5 July 2022** – Full closure of the A4097 Kingsbury Road from M6 Toll northbound entry slip to Dunton Island, including Kingsbury Road roundabout.

## What does this mean for you?

During closures, we'll provide a fully signed diversion route (please see the following pages for further details).

I'd also like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disruption to those living close to the work. We'll make every effort to carefully manage noise levels and additional lighting to minimise the impact.

Access will be maintained throughout for the emergency services.

Please note, our planned work may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. We will not work over bank holidays, including the Queen's Jubilee on Thursday 2 and Friday 3 June 2022.

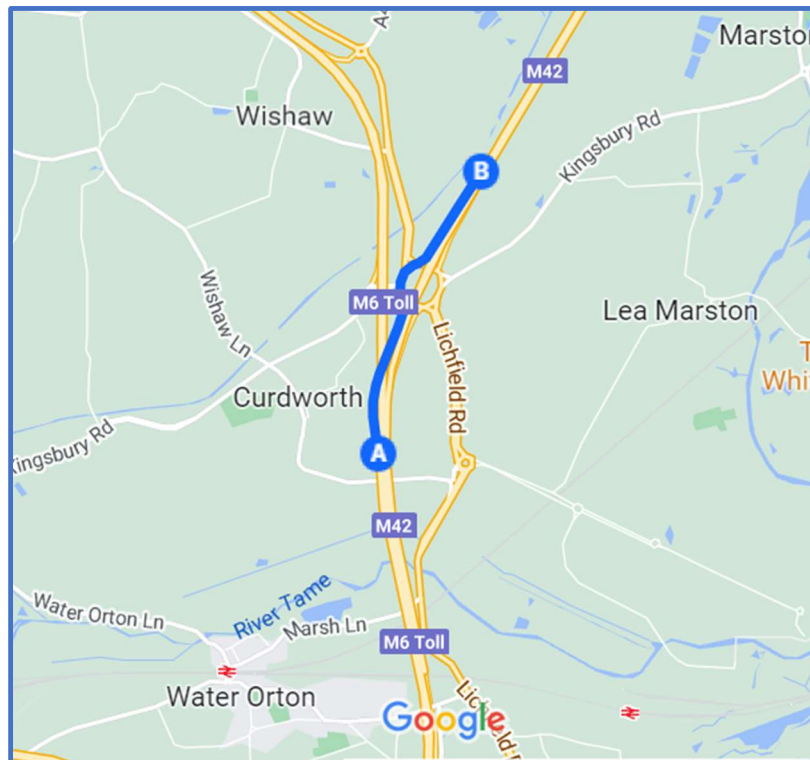

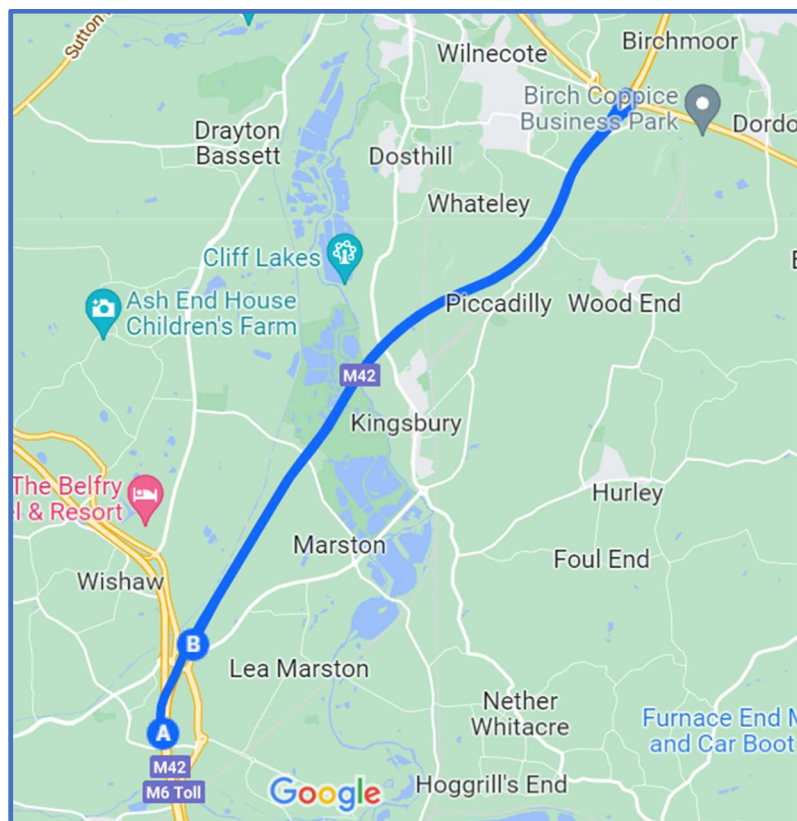

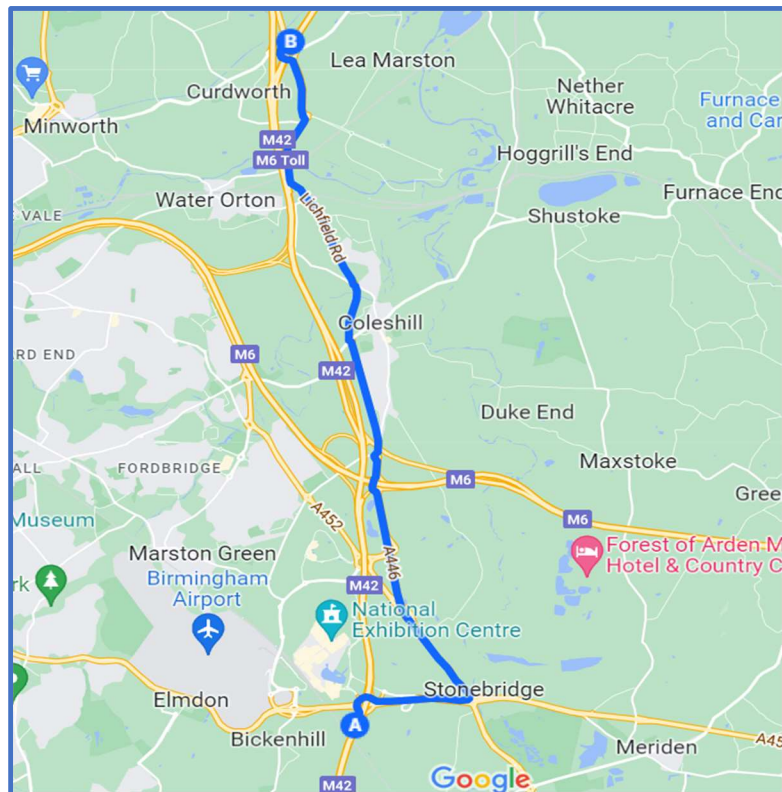
## Phase 1 diversion route:



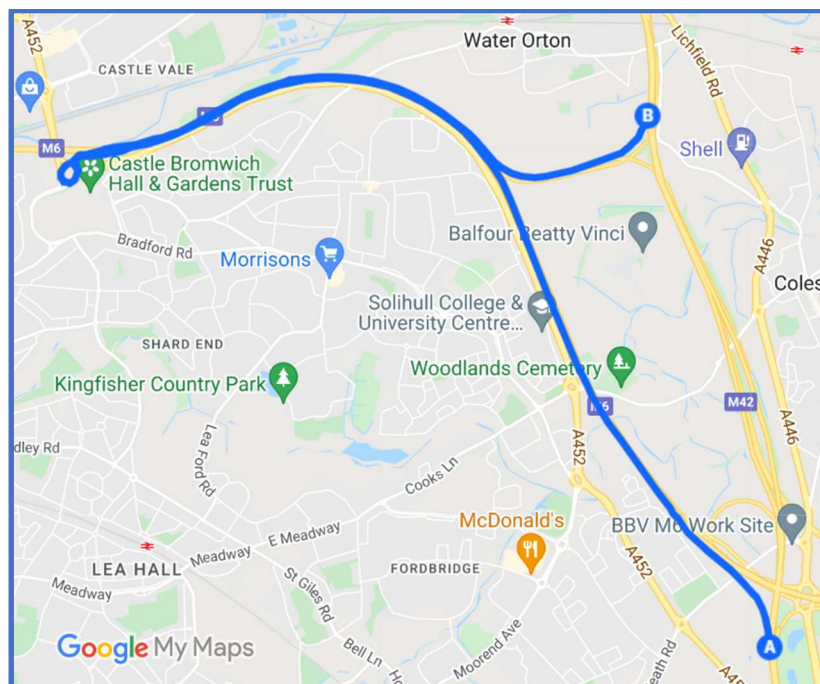
## Phase 2 diversion route:
