High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are being carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons, known as LM.

We're improving the local road network

Since 2017, we have been remodelling and improving sections of the existing road network near Northway Island and creating new routes on HS2 land. Upon completion, a new T-junction will replace Northway Island. A new 'longabout' is already in operation outside the Holiday Inn Express NEC, on the way to the National Exhibition Centre (NEC).

We need to conduct some maintenance to the verges on the M42 overbridge.

Single lane closures, weekdays and off peak only, between 18 September to 5 October 2023

Single lane closures will be in place on the M42 overbridge from 18 September to 5 October 2023, week days only from 9.30am to 3.30pm. The work will start on the northbound side and then switch to the southbound side (see map on page 2).

If this work can be completed ahead of schedule, the lane closures will be removed in advance of the 5 October.

These works are subject to obtaining the relevant consents.

Duration of works

Temporary off peak single lane closures will be in place from 9.30am to 3.30pm, weekdays, from 18 September to 5 October 2023.

Lane closures will be phased to manage impacts on the network.

Keep all sites safe and secure

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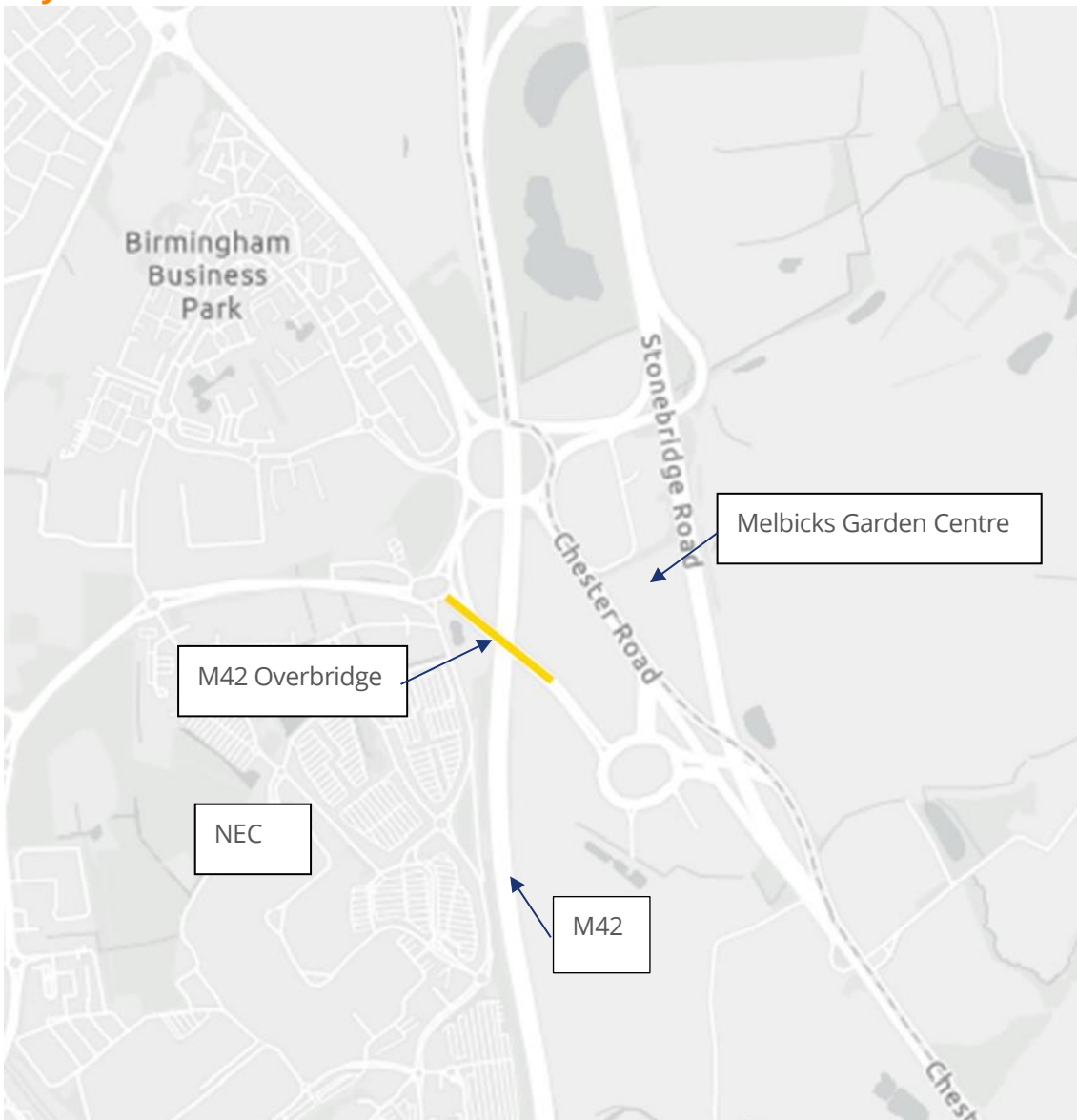

Single off peak lane closure, 18 September to 5 October 2023

During maintenance works to the verge on the M42 overbridge, there will be a single lane closure in place weekdays between 9.30am and 3.30pm from 18 September to 5 October. The lane closure will start on the northbound side and then be moved to the southbound side.
