Welcome to Bickenhill & Marston Green Parish Council's website. If you continue to browse and use this website, you are agreeing to comply with and be bound by the following terms and conditions of use, which together with our privacy policy govern our relationship with you in relation to this website. The term 'Bickenhill & Marston Green Parish Council' or 'Parish Council' or 'Council' or 'us' or 'we' refers to the owner of the website. The term 'you' refers to the user or viewer of our website.

Privacy and Website Cookies

Bickenhill & Marston Green Parish Council (the 'Council') will always respect the privacy of individuals who browse its website and leave contact details. This policy applies to information the Council collects about:

Contacting Bickenhill & Marston Green Parish Council: information collected about you

The Council regards its visitors' privacy as being of the utmost importance. It collects the following personal information:

- name
- email address
- telephone number

Any information you submit, either through this website or through any other means such as email, telephone or letter, will be regarded as confidential, and will not be passed to any 3rd party without your express prior permission. The Council gathers the information to allow it to process any requests for services or orders for products made and to provide the services or deliver the goods requested. Any such information will be stored and/or disposed of in accordance with applicable data protection legislation.

Use of Cookies

This website is powered by WordPress. Cookies are used only to ensure proper running. They are not used for tracking purposes, just to hold site information for the duration of your browsing session.
